2025-2026 Competition Season

All clubs, coaches, judges, and athletes must be current members in good standing with USA Gymnastics in order to be eligible to enter and attend competitions. Please review and complete all requirements for your membership category.

Coach Requirements

To be permitted on the competition floor, all coaches must have completed the following:

- Professional Membership Payment
- Fundamentals of Gymnastics Instruction (U100)
- Safety Certification (U101)
- SafeSport Certification (U110)
- Annual Rules Update (T210)
- Background Check through USA Gymnastics
- Tough Coaching/Emotion Abuse (U112)
- Concussion Education Acknowledgement

If any requirement is incomplete, your status on USA Gymnastics will be listed as “Pending”, and you will not be permitted on the competition floor.

Note: Professional members are expected to wear proper attire at all competitions.

Athlete Requirements

All athletes age 18 and older must complete the SafeSport Course – [Access Here](#)

Athletes turning 18 during the competition year may access the SafeSport course with parent permission through their USA Gymnastics Member Services account.

Competition Requirements for Clubs and Meet Directors

All competition venues and dates will be secured by the PTAU State Board and paid using the State account. After booking, the total rental cost for the season will be divided equally among all meet directors, who will then reimburse the State for their portion.

Club Responsibilities

Clubs are responsible for:

- Submitting complete athlete rosters by December 26 for all meets.
- Submitting any level changes no later than 4 weeks before each meet.
- Ensuring club payments are submitted 4 weeks before each meet.
- Keeping all athlete information accurate and up to date.
- Maintaining professional conduct at all times.
- Providing an available Judge affiliated with their club, when possible.

Rosters may temporarily reopen when competition dates overlap.

In these situations, rosters will reopen for changes from the weekend of the previous competition until Sunday at midnight.

Meet Director Responsibilities

Meet Directors must:

- Submit schedules and all required paperwork on time.
- Communicate clearly and consistently with the State Board first, followed by all participating clubs.
- Complete Technical Rep meetings 3 weeks before each meet.
- Distribute start lists 2 weeks before each meet.
- Release meet schedules 2 weeks before each meet.
- Provide equipment layouts prior to each competition.
- Ensure EMT/medical staff are onsite at all times, per USAG requirements.

Warm-Up Standards

Levels 3–7: Standardized warm-up procedures will continue to be used statewide.

Level 8+: Receive 15-minute apparatus warm-ups.

Open Warm-Up Times: May be added at the meet director's discretion.

Awards

Regular Season Meets: Awards will be presented per flight immediately following each event.

State Championships: Awards will be combined by USAG age group and level, not by flight.

Athlete Entry Fee Distribution

From each athlete entry at every sanctioned meet, \$17.50 is allocated to the PTAU State Fund. These funds support the operations of the association as well as athlete scholarships and financial assistance.

State funds are used for, but not limited to, the following areas:

Travel Fund

Judges Fund

High School Scholarship Fund

Materials & Equipment Fund

Additionally, \$1.00 from each athlete entry is paid directly to USA Gymnastics.

After discussion and review with member clubs, meet directors, and judges, the PTAU Board voted to approve a \$10.00 increase to support State-level funding and long-term budgeting needs.

2025-2026 Athlete Travel Funding Plan

Assuming sufficient funds are available PTAU hopes to fund all National Team endeavors any PTAU athlete achieves. The following are the ideals assuming funds are available:

Assignment/Team Selection	Amount per Year
World Age Groups-Athlete	\$1500-2000*
Selected, partial funded Coach International Travel	Up to \$2000, as fund allows**
National Team Camp-Athlete	\$550 1st camp, \$275additional camps
EDP Camp-Athlete	\$275 per athlete
EDP Camp-Coach	Self-Funded
Jumpstart Camp-Athlete	Up to \$275
Jumpstart Camp-Coach	Self-Funded

*Funding will be distributed no less than the minimum amount, up to the top amount dependent on number of athletes attending and funds available

**Coaches funding refers to per club, not per coach

Athlete Scholarship

Four \$1500 scholarships available each year.
Paid directly to the university or trade school of choice.
One scholarship reserved specifically for Developmental level athletes.

Eligibility:

Competitive athlete from a club within PTAU
Current athlete member in good standing with USAG
Senior in High School or Current student at a university/college/trade school

Criteria:

Application, Essay and Letter of Recommendation required
State Board reviews and ranks each application package
Quality of Essay, past involvement in the sport, Recommendation letter, future involvement in the sport are all taken into consideration
